MacularProtect® is a dietary supplement for those concerned about preserving macular health. The formula is based on the findings of both the original Age-Related Eye Disease Study (AREDS) and the follow-up (AREDS2). The original trial showed that high-risk patients given antioxidants with zinc had a significantly better chance of retaining their vision. MacularProtect delivers the antioxidant nutrients vitamins C and E, zinc, and copper that were included in AREDS. Antioxidants help combat oxidative stress, a process that can damage structures within the eye.

The Important Role of Lutein

Lutein and zeaxanthin are also featured in this formula at the levels tested in AREDS2. Concentrated in foods such as spinach, kale and corn, these nutrients form the yellow pigment of the macula lutea – the area at the center of the eye's retina where the sharpest central vision occurs. Regular intake of lutein and zeaxanthin contributes to the density of this protective macular pigment. Many Americans, however, consume less than 2 mg daily – far lower than the 10 mg tested in AREDS2.

Analyses of the AREDS2 trial showed that study participants who received lutein and zeaxanthin fared better than those who did not. Further benefit was seen for those with the lowest dietary intake of these nutrients. The researchers also determined that former smokers should avoid high dose betacarotene. Based on these findings, the National Eye Institute now recommends the original AREDS formula of antioxidants and zinc for high-risk patients, with lutein and zeaxanthin replacing the formerly included beta-carotene.

Emerging Science: A Key B-Vitamin Trio

MacularProtect provides ample amounts of three B-vitamins: folic acid, vitamin B6 and vitamin B12. Elevated blood levels of a compound called homocysteine can damage the inner lining of small blood vessels in the eye. The B-vitamins help keep levels of this compound lower, and evidence suggests that they support macular health.

A large-scale intervention trial in women found that high dose folic acid with vitamins B6 and B12 taken over a 7-year period improved their chances of maintaining macular health. Results of another long-term, population-health study support these clinical findings, and indicate that even moderate intakes of these B-vitamins may be beneficial.
